## *Instructions for posting video to YouTube*

Note: Once you edit your video, make sure it is smaller than 2 GB in size, in an acceptable file format.

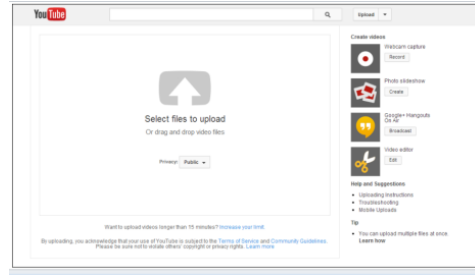
1. Go to [www.youtube.com](http://www.youtube.com). Click on “Create Account.” If you already have an account, click on “Sign In” and proceed to Step 4.

2. Complete the information shown below to set up your account. Then click on “I Accept.”

3. Once you have completed the account set-up, you should have a screen shown below confirming registration. Click on “Upload.”

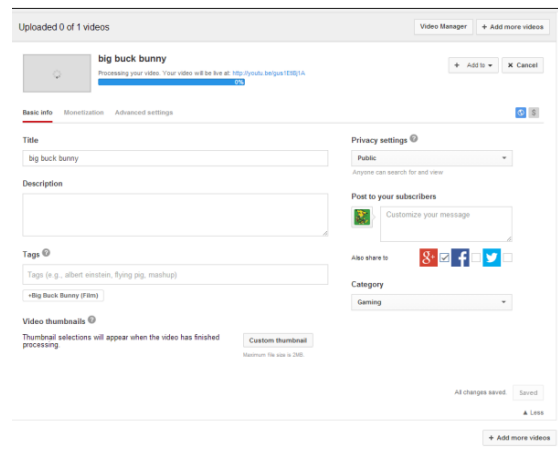
