Answer the following questions T or F in the blank to the left of the number.

- F 1. When passing a truck on an interstate, ride along beside for several seconds to be sure the truck is not going to change lanes.
- T 2. Red on signs always means stop or be prepared to stop.
- T 3. Trucks are larger and heavier than cars and pickups; therefore, they need more time and distance for stopping.
- F 4. The term “divided attention” refers to only those distractions on the roadway.
- F 5. When following a truck, stay closely and directly behind the trailer to avoid the wind draft.
- F 6. Anti-lock brakes require a pumping of the brake.
- F 7. Air bags have eliminated the need for safety belts.
